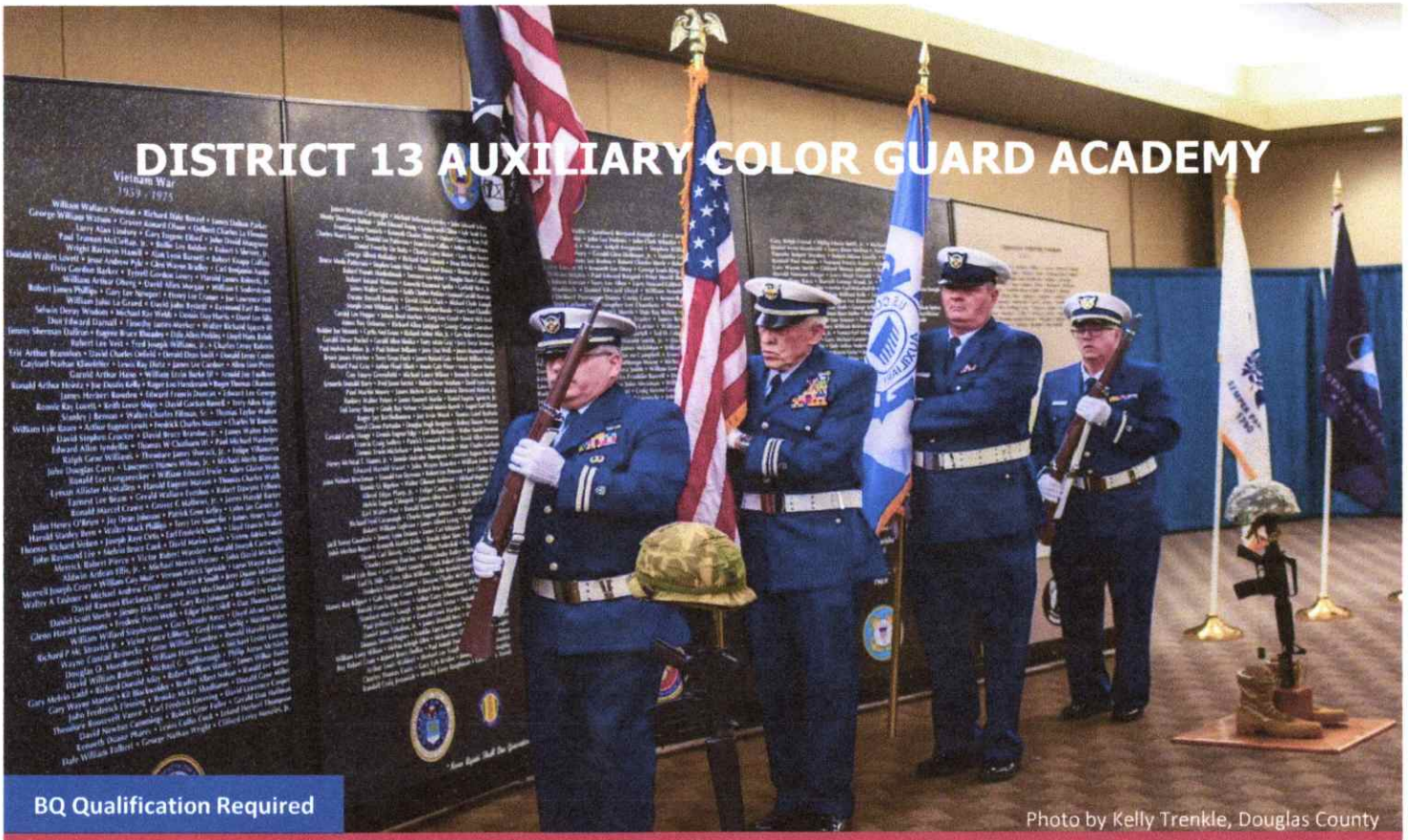

Auxiliary Color Guards provide excellent opportunities for ceremonial presence on behalf of the Coast Guard and the Auxiliary. They afford representational, recruiting, public outreach, and fellowship tools for Auxiliarists to demonstrate their long history of service pride and professionalism.

CLASSES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Presenting, posting, and retiring the Colors
- Proper wear of uniform
- Rifle Drill
- Ceremonial flag folding
- Marching
- Use of common commands
- Exam preparation
- PQS Standards Training and practice
