**COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:** (note some are offered as hybrid classes)

\*\*How to report ATON Discrepancies: All Auxiliarists are encouraged to report ATON discrepancies they observe. What are these discrepancies and how do you report them on a 7054 and Coast Guard. Friday 0900 to 1000

Chart Reading and Dead Reckoning: This will cover the required navigation tasks as listed in the Boat Crew Qualifications Guide. Friday 1100-1300

- \*\*Marine Safety Sea Partners. Aquatic Invasive Species discussion for Public Education. Friday 1000 to 1100
- \*\*OPS Workshop: Required annual workshop for crew on surface missions. Friday 0900-1000
- \*\*Oregon Marine Board Update: All instructors for Boat Oregon will be required to be certified or go through a refresher class by **OMB.** This class will go over the new requirements. Friday 1400 - 1500
- \*\*Vessel Examination (VE) Workshop: Required annual workshop (self attestation on some years) for those members conducting recreational boat examinations. Friday 1100-1200
- \*\*Photography for Public Affairs: This course covers the policies and procedures to take photographs that can be submitted for publication. Friday 1200-1300
- \*\*Aux Data II. Basic, plus Reports: Session 1, Basic covers tips on how to enter your own time for the 99 series missions plus those missions that historically required entry into form 7030. Session 2 covers Reports & how to locate existing reports and edit to make management reports . Friday 1400-1600.

Fire Extinguishers and Flares: Hands on use of fire extinguishers and use of hand held flares as per the Boat Crew Qualifications Guide. Friday 1600 to 1800

First Aid/AED: This course is the American Heart Association Certification First Aid class that is good for two years. There is a \$25 fee for the class. The instructors are USCG Aux members.. Saturday 0800-1200

- \*\*TCT Refresher: This risk management course is required every 15 months for all personnel that are conducting missions to support the Coast Guard. (Surface and Air Operations, Communications & Watchstanding, Marine Safety, Culinary, etc.) Saturday 1300-1700
- \*\*Auxiliary Prevention Outreach Specialist (MEES): This Marine Safety PQS class will cover the Maine Environmental Protection (MEP) missions and fundamentals. Missions that the Coast Guard Auxiliary can participate include the Beach Cleanup, Sea Partner, and lead into the Pollution Response mission. This is normally the second MS PQS that an auxiliarist would qualify in their MS career. Saturday 1300-1700

Color Guard: Practice and PQS for the Color Guard Mission. Friday 1600 to 1800

- \*\*Instructor Workshop: Annual required workshop for instructor qualified auxiliarists. Friday 1000 to 1100
- \*\*Classes that will also be offered as hybrid classes.
