Wait at least an hour per drink
before operating a boat.

Alcohol use is the leading factor
in fatal boating accidents.

There is NO safe threshold for
drinking and operating a boat.

It is illegal to drink and operate
a boat in all U.S. states.

The federal blood-alcohol limit
to operate a boat is .08%.

Intoxicated operators are 10 times
as likely to die in accidents.
