SUBJ: CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF EMERGENCY MANAGERS 2023 UNIFORMED, CIVILIAN, AND AUXILIARY MEMBER EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AWARDS

1. This ALCOAST solicits Coast Guard nominees for the International Association of Emergency Managers (IAEM) Uniformed Service Awards Competition in the following categories:
 - a. IAEM-USC Uniformed Emergency Manager of the Year
 - b. IAEM-USC Civilian Emergency Manager of the Year
 - c. IAEM-USC Auxiliary Emergency Manager of the Year
2. These awards recognize individuals serving in the uniformed services of the United States who have demonstrated significant contributions to the field of emergency management while self-developing as emergency managers.
3. The award guidelines are:
 - a. Eligibility: Uniformed members including Active Duty, Reserve, and Auxiliary members are eligible for nomination. Civilians, including civil service and service contractors, are eligible for nomination.
 - b. Nominations: Must be made and submitted by the first O-6 or GS-15 equivalent or above in the nominee's chain of command for the Military and Civilian categories. Nominations for the Auxiliary may be made and submitted by any Commodore, Squadron Commander, Director of Auxiliary, or O-6/GS-15 equivalent or above.
 - c. Submission requirements: Nominations must include a command recommendation memo with complete contact information for both the nominee and nominator and a one-page description, in bullet form, of significant achievements and contributions and must include the following categories: Accomplishments, Job Performance, Technical Competence, Leadership Ability, Initiative, and Resourcefulness.
 - d. Use of abbreviations is acceptable with an abbreviation list on a separate sheet. Use only Times New Roman font with 10 or 12 point font size.
 - e. Period of award: 1 JUL 2021 through 31 DEC 2022.
