Joining the Auxiliary Chaplains Support (ACS) Program

Program Prerequisites

Auxiliary Core Training.

Basic Qualifying Course (BQII) for those joined o/a 01 FEB 2018, and be a member in good standing.

Provide a completed Statement of Ecclesiastical Endorsement (ANSC-7070) from an Ecclesiastical Endorsing Agent authorized by an RO recognized by the Armed Forces Chaplains Board (AFCB)

Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university named on the U.S. Department of Education's list of Accredited Postsecondary Institutions and Programs.

Possess a post-baccalaureate graduate degree in the field of theological or related studies from a qualifying educational institution.

Obtain Letters of recommendation from the following:

- a) Flotilla Commander,
- b) USCG CO or OIC, and
- c) a USCG chaplain.

Complete all requirements of Commandant 1730.5A, the Auxiliary Chaplain Support Program
