## **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

Demonstrate corrective actions for combating a Fire onboard an auxiliary facility.

A drill will automatically be deemed unsatisfactory if any of the following conditions are met: (S)

- Jeopardizing safety of passengers and crew (i.e., Engine Cutoff Switch, jewelry, etc.)
- Unsafe operation or navigation of the boat
- Failure to wear and use serviceable crew safety and survival equipment.
- Failure to properly assign and utilize crewmembers.
- Failure to use applicable operational risk management and updating as necessary.

(COX) required for Coxswain.

(BCM) required for Crewmember.

All steps with an (S) must be performed for a satisfactory drill by the crew position(s) indicted.

INITIAL ACTION	
(S) Sound an alarm. Any crewmember who discovers a fire or any indication of fire must sound an alarm and give a location (e.g., "FIRE, FIRE IN THE BILGES"). (BCM)	
(S) Reduce RPM to neutral on engine(s). (COX)	
(S) Secure affected engine(s), if engine fire. (COX)	
(S) If engine fire, secure fuel source if safe to do so and if applicable (BCM)	
(S) Verify current position, depth of water, evaluated situation, and informed controlling authority of situation and location. (COX)	
(S) Initiate a MAYDAY call to alert boats in the area of the situation. (COX) or (BCM)	
(S) If boat is equipped with an automatic extinguishing system, ensure it is discharging. If the system is manually operated, on Coxswain command, energize it and check to ensure it is discharging.  CAUTION: Never enter a compartment after a fire until you are sure it has been properly ventilated. (COX) & (BCM)	
(S) If no installed extinguishing system and if safe to do so, on coxswain command, crew member combat fire using portable fire extinguisher. (COX) & (BCM)	
(S) If unable to extinguish fire, prepare life raft or dingy, if available, put it over the side and inflate it, if necessary. (COX) & (BCM)	
FOLLOW UP ACTIONS	
(S) Stand a fire watch, with portable fire extinguisher (if fire is extinguished). (BCM)	
Secure non-vital electrical power. (COX) & (BCM)	
Crew member rigs the anchor, as directed by the coxswain. (COX) & (BCM)	
(S) Discuss abandon boat options. Ensure all crewmembers are accounted for and have PPE/survival gear. Discuss operation of Personal Locator Beacon (PLB). (COX) & (BCM)	
(S) Inform unit/Operational Commander as situation/risk changes, tow or other assistance. (COX)
