EVALUATION CRITERIA

Given a Search Action Plan and a Commence Search Point (CSP), execute a drifting type search pattern.

For drill purposes:

- Complete minimum of five search pattern legs for the (SS) only.
- Complete (VS) in its entirety.
- Facility must have one or more of the following onboard: an operational GPS or Electronic Charting System (ECS) or compass and radio.
- Facility may have a radar.

A drill will automatically be deemed unsatisfactory if any of the following conditions are met: (S)

- Jeopardizing safety of passengers and crew (i.e., Engine Cutoff Switch, jewelry, etc.)
- Unsafe operation or navigation of the boat
- Failure to wear and use serviceable crew safety and survival equipment.
- Failure to properly assign and utilize crewmembers.
- Failure to use applicable operational risk management and updating as necessary.

All steps (as applicable) with an (S) must be performed.

PREPARATIONS	
(S) Brief crew on mission.	
(S) Assign lookouts, coordinate their areas of responsibility, and provide target description.	
Open windows (if installed), as necessary.	
SEARCH PATTERN EXECUTION	
Arrive within 100 yards of established CSP.	
(S) From the established CSP, estimate direction of set.	
(S) Calculate all compass courses, state starting speed over ground/times to turn for search pattern.	
(S) Ensure no part of the search pattern will create a navigational hazard to facility. i.e.: shoal water, land, Aids to Navigation, etc.	
(S) Deploy datum marker and mark position into GPS or ECS (VS only. Not required to deploy for (SS)).	
(S) Commence Search in estimated direction of set.	
(S) Advise Unit/SMC of on scene WX, position, and start time of pattern.	
Set speed and do not adjust throttles after first leg.	
(S) Commence all turns to the right, within + or - 15 seconds of calculated times to turn.	
Boat crew demonstrates proper visual scanning techniques.	
(S) (VS only): Steer on datum marker when on 3 rd , 6 th , and 9 th legs	
(S) (VS only): Enter final position of datum marker into GPS or ECS immediately upon completing final leg. (Not required for (SS)).	
(S) (SS only): Complete minimum five search pattern legs.	
Calculate set and drift upon completion of search pattern.	
(S) Notify Unit/SMC of completion of search pattern. Pass final position of search pattern.	
Use illumination without compromising night vision (if at night).


